Complaints to the BBC: November 2009

The BBC answered just over **17,500** complaints from the audience in November 2009. These ranged from a small number of complaints about potentially serious breaches of editorial guidelines through to a much larger collection of views about programme content and services.

The voting outcomes on Strictly Come Dancing attracted complaints this month. Some viewers were also unhappy with comments made by the judging panel on the show when assessing a performance by one of the celebrity contestants on 7 November.

Some viewers complained following reports that a Liberal Democrat MP was dropped from the Question Time panel in advance of the 26 November broadcast and we continued to receive complaints following the appearance of a representative of the British National Party on the programme on 22 October.
