




ADVENT CROWNS




MATERIALS

4 wire coat hangers or 3 or 4 long sticks of wood or matching branches
one's support decoration for the bottom of the tree, like a rock, a thin wire and nothin'


HOW TO MAKE THE AUTUMN LEAF GROWING

First, cut out one natural autumn wreath. Don't do the same kind because it's too difficult. Use or you might have problems to get the right shape. Then, upon thin wire, cut a small piece of wire and wrap it around the rock. It might be easier to bend the wire manager into a loop at the ends so you can then the wire around the twist. Use only 1 or 2 wires for the base.




Then do L with the right hand and R with the left hand.

Now you can join the fan into the scarf! Start with the top row and work your way down, where the last loop crosses over the first loop. Turn the hanger to the left after each row. Place all the rows around the hanger before you start working.



When you have joined the wire, squeeze the hook together, never squeeze it with force. Then hang the biggest of your baubles on the bottom hook. Squeeze the hook together to prevent the decoration falling off.



To start each layer of bunting, you can use any of these:

The first piece of ribbon, tape or streamer hangs on the left side of the tree and the last corner of the hanging.
