KIM

KIM

NEIL (CONT'D)

I've tried to discuss the underlying issues, but bring any nuance to the debate and you get shouted down.

KIM

Kim gets a text message from Amy telling her Izzy and Tommy Charles are in the school.

KIM (CONT'D)

(to Neil)

Sorry, can we do this later?

As Kim goes, Neil's left disappointed but unsurprised by her response.

KI M

(sombre)

Morning Waterloo Road.

(she takes a moment)

As you know, last week there was a

fatality outside school. (indicating picture)

Her name was Chlo Charles.

Some excitement / some dismay at that.

 $$\operatorname{KIM}$$  (CONT'D) We are all in this together. We are Waterloo Road.

As Kim steps down from the stage, some - like Caz, Samia and Kelly Jo, whoop and applaud that. Others are against.

DEA



The doorbell's ringing and Donte's got himself up, in T-shirt and boxers, wiping his eyes as he stumbles to answer.

We're expecting it to be Izzy, Tommy and the teachers - but it's a ME







DEA

TONYA

Mum, we have to.

NI CKY

We'll see about that.

**PRESTON** 

You telling me you're too tight to buy your own kid's uniform?

NI CKY

(missing a tiny half beat, like she's not giving her true answer) It's the principle.

But as Nicky fast marches away, genuine worry lines her face.

CORAL (CONT'D)
I take it you've got no marking or lesson planning?

Amy blanches, puts down the tin and goes to find some work.

KIM

Nicky, do you want to - ? (GO INTO MY OFFICE)

Nicky does so, full of the kind of tension that says she's anticipating a big argument.

KIM (CONT'D)

How about we discuss this further next time we have an official Head Pupil catch-up?

CAZ

You're fobbing me off, Miss. You're doing it nicely, but you're still fobbing me off.

Caz goes.

WATERLOO ROAD S11A EP #110

Year 11 (including Noel and Kelly Jo) are in history class with Neil.

NEIL

The Hundred Years War. I take it we've all watched the module now, so, what did we think?

SAMI A

Sir, you've still got that up.

She points at a wall display: the British Empire, illustrated by portraits and statues of the 'great and good'.

**NEIL** 

As I've already explained, that's because we should pay attention to the historical record, not whoever shouts the loudest.

KELLY JO

Many of the class reacts loudly, shouting him down, jeering. Others, like Noel, jeer at the jeerers.

NEIL (CONT'D)

William Beswick did a lot of good in his time -

More uproar.

NEIL

The place collapses into jeers and arguments and throwing paper balls at each

DONTE (CONT'D) Bet she could do with a hand looking after Sparky.

Tommy looks down at the toy in his hand.

I ZZY

I'll give Mum your toy.

TOMMY

Won't she be upset?

DONTE

Not with you, mate. Not with you.

Donte fires Izzy a remorseful look, acknowledging that it's him she'd be upset with.

DONTE (CONT'D)

Go on.

Donte hugs Tommy and then Tommy heads out to the neighbour.

Izzy looks at him, appreciating the gesture.

I ZZY

We'd better go.

DONTE

Yeah.

Donte puts a hand on her shoulder and leads them out, we watch them go and as Tommy heads off with the neighbour, Izzy and Donte get in the hearse.

Kim hurries to the car park - and pauses as she sees fresh graffiti on a wall:

She gets into the car, now slow and sullen, closes the door and sits staring into space, disappointed in her pupils, their parents, her teachers but mostly herself.

Shola gets into the car.

As Kim does likewise there's a look on her face that suggests she's far from certain about what she's just decided to do. But she gets into the car, decision made.

J0E

Danny, qui et.

Lindon takes out his phone and walks out of the office.

JOE (CONT'D)

Don't move.

Joe goes after Lindon.

Before Kim and Shola Leave, a distraught Izzy gives a tiny wave to Shola, no animosity, just glad to see her.

CELEBRANT Donte, shall we take a moment -

DONTE

I can't do it.

Donte pulls away, too emotional to continue. He gets down from the podium and walks out of the crem.

Izzy and Tommy watch him go, distraught.

JANEECE (CONT' D)

Lindon looks at him, unflinching. Joe's had enough, and goes back into the office, furious.





LI NDON

You say that now.

DANNY

I'll do the work.

J0E

Mr King.

Lindon looks round - the officer nearly upon them. Lindon looks at Joe and Danny, shrugs. What can I do? He goes to the office and emerges with the bag of cannabis.

LI NDON

In there, Lewis.

Danny miserably goes into the office - as the Police Officer reaches them.

LINDON (CONT'D)

Officer. Think this is for you.

Joe's glaring at Lindon like he's a rat.

Lindon hands over the drugs.

POLICE OFFICER

And you don't know who it belongs

Joe frowns - what?

LI NDON

Found it over by the gates this morning... No idea whose it is.

Joe tries not to look surprised.

POLICE OFFICER

One of yours probably dropped it.

LI NDON

That's what we thought. Isn't it Mr Casey?

J0E

Yeah, yeah. That's what we thought.

Lindon steps back in, to find Danny agog.

LINDON Very last chance.

Lindon gives him a hard look, and then walks out. Danny shoots him a hateful look as he leaves, then sits, and with renewed determination, begins to write.

Neil walks in with a cup of tea, ready for next lesson. And stops in shock as he sees the state of his classroom: displays ripped down, books scattered, 'RACEIST' (sic) written on the walls.

Amy is taking Year 11, including Kelly Jo, Samia, Dean and Noel. Samia is answering a question in the background while we're on Dean and Noel.

NOFI

You think he's been thrown out though?

DEAN

(bad tempered)

I dunno.

NOEL

Would he still be able to live in the hostel and that?

DEAN

I dunno!

NOEL

You think maybe we should have said something?

DEAN

(Shakes his head)
My dad will leather us if I get kicked out of school.

Dean looks troubled, like he's wrestling with

**NEIL** 

She's got a very distinctive style.

SAMI A

She was with me all through lunch actually, except when she went to - (voice fades, realising)
See the new uniform.

Kelly Jo stands up.

KELLY JO

Alright, Mr Historical Facts, it were me.

**NEIL** 

Come on.

SAMI A

Froghead -

KELLY JO

What d'you expect when you're all like 'William Beswick did good too'? Cos he paid for some museums an' that? Yeah I'd have been dead impressed while I was chained up in the bottom of his boat!

AMY

Kelly Jo, Mr Guthrie's asked you -

KELLY JO

Cos that's where I would have been, make no mistake, stolen from my family, living like a dog. And her. And her. And him. And if you want that name on your chest, you're as bad as all the people that let him do it. Worse. Cos you just don't care about no-one but yourself.

(glowering at Dean)

No-one.

The colour drains from Dean's face as he listens to all that.

Kelly Jo miserably stamps out with Neil, watched by a flustered Samia... and a perturbed Dean... at last learning the true meaning of empathy.

Lindon's working as Danny again scribbles away, determinedly, at his books. He finishes. Looks over what he's done. And then, tersely, almost challengingly, hands over his work.

Lindon begins to read through. After a moment he reads more carefully, surprised; impressed even. He looks up at Danny.

LI NDON

This is good.

DANNY

I know. And the next one's going to be good, and the next one. I'm going to stick it out, Sir, just cos you don't think I can.

LI NDON

I'll be happy to be wrong.

Danny looks at him dubiously, before t



Joe sits thinking, as a subdued Kim comes and plonks down next to him.
